4. Matters raised by members of the public of interest or concern relevant to the parish:

Residents raised concerns regarding driving at inappropriate and or excessive speeds through the village. A request for a reduction in speed limits (to 20mph) along Church Lane, Blacksmith's Lane, Mill Lane, Water Lane were received along with action to be taken to curb inappropriate speeds along The Street (Barnham-Euston Road) and to extend 30mph limit through existing 40mph limit. Not all present were in agreement with the need to reduce the 30mph limits to 20mph along Church Lane etc.

Mr Hollis offered to take on the role of Community Speedwatch co-ordinator, enabling the Speedwatch team to be reinstated.

It was agreed to discuss all matters raised during the subsequent parish council meeting.

It was agreed that the Chair would discuss with Mr Hollis, his offer to take on the role of Speedwatch coordinator, and subject to agreement would then seek to reinstate the Speedwatch team.
