NEWS FROM EUSTON ESTATE

Hello from Euston Farm. Harvest has now been completed which is always a great milestone for myself and the team to achieve. 4 weeks of long hours certainly gets tiresome after a while. The new combine performed perfectly with only one breakdown this season. All the baling has been completed and carted away and stacked. Now we turn to applying our organic manures like chicken muck and Digestate from the AD Plant. Next will be the primary fieldwork preparations like subsoiling and ploughing. Other Estate news is our forestry management plan is nearly complete with our woodland thinning which has been a huge job. Within that we have had to deal with an infection in Christmas trees called the Ips 8 Toothed Beetle. This has meant we have had a plant health order from the forestry commission telling us to fell all infected and potential host trees on the estate. This has been done which was 441 trees to be felled. Some were tiny but did include huge fully grown ones too. Best wishes Matthew Hawthorne Euston Farm
