### BARNHAM PARISH COUNCIL

**Residents are always welcome at meetings** of the parish council, during which a wide variety of village matters are discussed. Matters discussed during the September meeting included (and followed up) : the potential North Farm Quarry site reinstatement; traffic light sequencing/timing on the A134; Havebury Garages at Mill Lane which have not yet been returned to use; the loss of the climbing wall facility at the play park due to removal of the foot/hand holds by persons unknown; Vertas ( village grass cutting)- satisfaction with the work carried out to-date (1<sup>st</sup> year of the contract) and agreement to continue with the annual contract with Grainger Pest Control (moles). The parish council agreed to fund work to reconfigure several car parking spaces in front of the village hall and an area of hatching. Positive news regarding the clock face refurbishment project is expected soon.

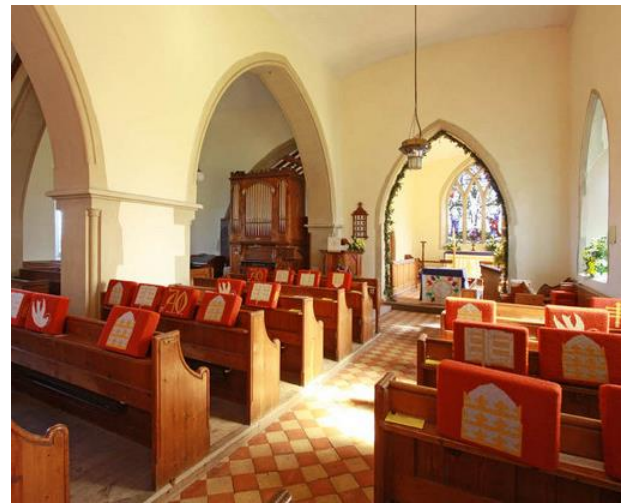
## A plea to everyone who lives in Barnham

This is St Gregory's, your Parish Church.



It is a fine building, with a Grade 2 listing from English Heritage. It has stood in the village for over 800 years. You can come into your Church to join us in worship or just to sit quietly by yourself and have some thinking time away from other pressures. You and your family can be christened here and married here. Your funeral can take place here. This is your Parish, your Church.

Did you know that your parish church receives no income at all from the Church of England, the Government or any Borough or County Council to help with any of the costs? Running and maintaining your Church costs over £17,000 a year. That's £325 every week. We have to raise enough money to pay our costs entirely from giving by people who live in the Parish or visit our Church. We are very grateful to everybody who attends and supports our fundraising activities, such as the Farmer's Markets, Coffee mornings and lunches. And we are also very thankful for those who already give a regular amount to the church, but right now we are not receiving enough money to keep your Church going for ever.



Today we are asking everyone in the village, if you would like to and are able to, give a small regular sum so that your Parish Church can continue to be here for you. Could you buy the church what would be the price of a coffee and cake once a month? Just £5 from enough people each month would help tremendously.
